We are pleased to report that all four of our licenses with the State of CA, our finances, personnel records, training documents, programs, property and assets are all in excellent condition for another year! We continue to remain faithful to our mission; "To assist vulnerable young people and their families in rebuilding their lives through caring relationships and opportunities to grow mentally, physically, socially and spiritually by living in a safe and healthy family."

As you can see from the numbers below we have now worked with over 1700 children, youth a young adults in all of our programs since we started in May 1987. As a result of the internet, email, Facebook and cell phones we still hear from many of our former children and youth. They are spread all over the USA and as a result of the military, some are overseas, fighting for our country's freedom. Our oldest kids are now in their 40's (close to my age...haha)! Many of them are married, have their own children and are earning an honest living for themselves and their families. THE CYCLE HAS BEEN BROKEN! The seeds we have planted in their lives are in some ways still germinating and in other ways are blooming in the next generation!




