From Transition to New Life

We hope you had a wonderful time with family and friends this month for Independence Day!

It is the perfect month to talk about Independence. We are focusing on our Transitional Living Home this month which provides a home for young men 18-24 years old who have experienced homelessness.

We just received a grant that will help us provide a home for even more youth who are homeless and in need of care. VTR will assist youth move into private market apartments and lease them in their own name. Our grant will help them with rental assistance, on average 9-12 months, and up to 24 months, reducing the amount gradually in order to help the youth towards their ultimate goal of independence. Our staff will continue services such as building life skills, connecting them to other resources and mentor them into their dreams of a better future...

We continue to pray for our young people, and for the ability to help more youth.

Transitional Living Home Success Story After 5 Months, From Homelessness to Independence!

The Transitional Living Home (TLH) for young men ages 18-24 come to us homeless, but with different needs. Through our mentorship, support, and education, they can get their feet on the ground to move forward in life.

Before coming to VTR, one of our young men had been homeless for several years. He had difficulty holding on to a job or pursuing any educational opportunities. He had never known his father and had recently lost his mother, who was also homeless.

One month after being with us, he was able to enroll at Fresno City College and received financial aid. He was able to apply and receive his healthcare and food subsidy. Within two months he obtained part-time employment. Within three months he found full-time employment with paid benefits with a worldwide corporation.

Staying at our Transitional Living Home gave him the opportunity to save all of his work earnings, financial aid and stimulus distributions. He also reconnected with a family member and eventually exited the program.

This young man was able to find stable housing and employment with five months of placement with us! If you can help TLH, please give today.

That's approximately 3.5 million young adults One in 30 youth ages 13-17 experienced homelessness over a 12-month period.

These young men who are experiencing homelessness are in unstable or inadequate living situations. Such living situations include sleeping on friends' couches, staying in shelters, living under bridges, in abandoned buildings, and on the streets.

VTR has a new grant from Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to provide help for even more young men who need housing and services in our Transitional living program. The funding however does not cover all our expenses we incur to get them off the streets and bring stability to their lives.

It has been on our heart and in our plans to

not only maintain the residence we have, but to grow this much needed program.

Since 2002 donors like you have helped us meet this need. We have been able to help hundreds of young men through providing them shelter, life skills education, mentoring and more. Our hope, our mission, is wrapped up in their precious lives and in the hope for their future.

We want you to know that we have developed a very successful program and there is none like ours. Young men are given time to navigate their way from homelessness to achieving stability and independence.
