## **Foster Care Needs**

VTR Foster care often requires additional resources beyond grants to effectively support children and families in need. These resources can come from a variety of sources and can be critical for providing comprehensive care. Here are some key resources provided by VTR and Resources in the community:

- Emergency Shelter and Housing Resources are necessary for immediate placement when children are removed from unsafe
- Many foster children have experienced trauma and require specialized therapeutic services, including access to counseling and mental health support.
- Educational support is often necessary as Foster children may struggle academically due to disruptions. Resources such as tutors, after-school programs, and educational advocates are essential to help them succeed in school.
- Respite care provides care for foster families and can help prevent burnout and ensure the stability of foster placements.
- Legal representation is often needed to advocate for foster children's rights and best interests.
- Foster families and foster youth benefit from support groups that provide a sense of community, information sharing, and emotional support.
- Many foster children require transportation to school, appointments, and visitations. Access to reliable transportation resources is essential.
- VTR may ask for funding for expenses not covered by grants, including clothing, school supplies, extracurricular activities, and special needs.
- Training resources that promote cultural competence and diversity are essential for foster families and professionals to understand better and meet the unique needs of each child.
- VTR often advocates for local, state, and national policy changes to improve the foster care system. Resources for advocacy efforts are crucial.
- Building partnerships with other community organizations, schools, healthcare providers, and government agencies can help share resources and support the holistic needs of foster children and families.
